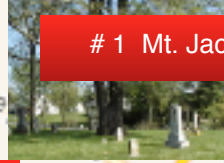


A Driving Tour from: 1.Mt. Jackson, colored Cemetery; 2. Corhaven Cemetery;
3. John Kline Homestead and 4. Arkton

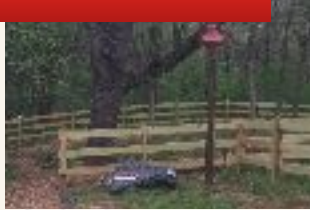
1 Start the tour at the Mt. Jackson Colored Cemetery. Take Mt. Jackson exit off I 81 and go east and make right onto Rt. 11 South/Main Street. Make right onto Nelson Lane and the cemetery will be just across the RR tracks on your left.

2 From the cemetery in Mt. Jackson, head south on Rt. 11/Main Street. Make a right onto Quicksburg Rd. Go past the little town of Quicksburg and Corhaven will be about 1/2 mile on your right. Park at the barn and go through the gate and across the field to the cemetery. Please close the gate behind you.

3 Continue west from Corhaven and make a left onto Rt. 42. Go through Timberville and make a right onto Springbrook Lane. The Kline Homestead will be next to the Broadway High School on your right. The Linville Church of the Brethren cemetery will be next to the church on your left.

4 When you leave the John Kline Homestead make a left onto Springbrook and then make a right onto Rt. 259/Mayland Rd. Continue on Rt. 11 and make a right onto Arkton Rd. near Tenth Legion. Make a left onto Mountain Valley Rd. You will find the monument pictured below a short distance on your right. This is where the Colored School was following the Civil War. It was next to a Brethren Church and not far from the old Moore farm where Dennis Beasley and others are buried in their slave cemetery.
